### "Falling"

I was never much of a thrill seeker. Truth is I have always kind of been more of a chicken (in a really cool way of course). You see, I never would admit that I was afraid of doing something because I didn't want to have to deal with the ramifications of what my friends thought. So, I would muster up enough courage to do just enough of whatever I needed to do to save face with my buddies. I rarely was the first to jump (or whatever) but likely was the one egging the others on toward stupidity. The problem was if they ended up surviving the "whatever," it only meant that my turn was soon to follow (along with the other cool guys, not like the idiots who went first).

I remember rock climbing on some massive boulders in Montana when I was a teenager. The thought of climbing up the crevices and footholds of those huge rocks sounded rather exciting and exhilarating, but then came the dim voice of reason somewhere deep in the recesses of my mind. Now, listening to reason was never my strong suit in those days, instead I tended to listen much more closely to the voice of idiots. On this particular day, my friend quickly began to traverse up the big rock and even though I was really afraid, I faced my fears (ignored reason) and started climbing. As long I was only 6-8 feet from the ground, I was fine. I figured if things went bad I could just slide back down and absorb the fall. But, the higher I climbed and the more precarious the rock became, the more nervous I got. I can still feel the nervous feeling in my gut as I contemplated the "what if" of falling. Some profoundly important questions began to flood my mind like, "Who would come to the funeral, who would be sad, who would be happy....?" All these thoughts were running through my head as I was clinging precariously to that rock. (I have found out in life that I tend to do my best thinking after-the-fact.) It has often been said that falling is never really the problem in situations like this, instead it always that sudden stop at the end of the fall. Well, I know you are reading breathlessly awaiting the loud "thud" at this point in the story, but thankfully it never came for me or my buddies. Falling from that rock never happened and we survived that adventure to go back many more times.

Falling is not what anyone plans to do. Falling is never the objective in most situations, but too frequently it is the outcome. Falling happens in many more situations than on rocks and mountains, it happens in marriages, in temptations, and it happens spiritually. Recently, I have read a number of articles, books, etc. about people who once seemed to be on fire for the Lord who have now chosen to walk away from the truth that they once proclaimed. It just seems that recently there have been several relatively high profile people who had some level of Christian notoriety who have simply thrown in the towel and said they no longer know what they believe, or if they do. Presently, I am reading a book written by a man who I remember speaking in chapel when I was in college who has "fallen" from what he once believed. It is all really quite sad and makes me wonder what did it take for them to get to that point? Nobody starts this journey as a Christian with the intent of falling away.

Each of us is susceptible to falling in one way or another. For some that may mean falling into a temptation that we would have never believed we would give into. To others it may be a fall that begins by being deceived to believe or feel something that is not true or right. Still others, may succumb to a total abandonment of what it meant to even once be called a Christian. My point is simply to acknowledge that there is nothing more that the enemy would desire except to cause any of us who claim the name of Christ to fall in some way. Paul warned us about a "falling away" (2 Thessalonians 2:3) that would take place prior to some of the events of the last days. There have been many people who were much smarter and more gifted than us, who have fallen. It is not about our strength or personal resolve, but about being anchored to one much greater than ourselves.

Now, the good news! Listen to what Jude wrote, "Now unto Him that is able to keep you from falling and to prevent you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy" (v. 24). Reality is that falling is what human beings have been doing ever since that first "fall" in the garden, and it happens when we try to operate in our own strength. The key is found in our relationship with the person of Jesus and the power of His Spirit who promises to empower us so that we won't fall. When you experience doubts that you cannot reconcile, trust the great reconciler. When you have fears that seem to close in all around you, trust the Prince of Peace. When you are tempted to throw aside any vestiges of faith, trust the one who is faithful even when our faith falters. Falling is not inevitable, but it is always a possibility. So, stand firm in the faith and trust the Savior!




