

"Trump Card"

DISCLAIMER: THE FOLLOWING CONTENT MAY BE DIFFICULT FOR SOME TO HANDLE, READ AT YOUR OWN DISCRETION... (if anybody actually reads these articles anyway). No, no, I will not be wading into politics or into anything regarding our previous (and maybe next) President in this article. So, feel free to take a deep breath and join back with me in a minute. Feel better?

For those of you who know me, you know that I like to play all types of board and card games. In fact, I picked out a couple of new ones for my wife to give me for Christmas. Growing up, our family would frequently gather around our dinner table and play games. Holidays allowed us the time to have an extended game day marathon. If it were, then we would always feel warm fuzzies and affection toward others in every circumstance. The Bible tells us that "God is love" (1 Jn 4:16) and we rejoice in that. The Bible tells us that "God so loved the world" (Jn 3:16) and we cherish that. The problem is that loving others is often not very easy to do, but it is always right to do. If we have enough faith to see God do the miraculous, but miss doing it with love, the Scripture says it is worthless (1 Cor. 13:2)! I am afraid that many of us may not really believe that---worthless?? The reason for the disclaimer at the beginning, was to warn you that something very provocative was to follow. Well, loving the unlovable and underserving is probably as provocative as it gets. It is so easy to become conditioned to emphasize knowing and believing the right things, but we are far less conditioned to emphasize on how we actually live that out. Yet, all faith without love, leads to nothing!! So, my prayer and focus for our Association of Laurens Baptist Churches is that in this New Year that we would truly choose to love others with a reckless abandon, which will not require any disclaimer but may lead us in being able to share about a God who so loved the world...
